This three story Romanesque-style structure was a gift of William A. Slater in memory of his father. Officially dedicated in 1886, the museum added the Cast collection in 1888 as the first of several collections which include the European and American paintings, contemporary American crafts, Asian textiles, Native American and pre-Columbian artifacts and African and Oceanic artifacts.
